Tasting Notes:

Southwest facing rocky soils at our estate vineyards in the Sierra foothills, together with warm days and cool nights have helped craft this lovely full bodied wine.

Deep ruby red in color this wine offers well balanced acidity with heady aromas and flavors of black cherries and cranberries with hints of cacao and oak followed by a long lingering finish.

The intensity of this wine will pair well with crusty herbed breads drizzled with olive oil, hearty casseroles and stews and flavorful roasted meats.

Naggiar Vineyards:

Located twelve miles south of Grass Valley, California and Nestled in the Sierra Foothills, Naggiar Vineyards encompasses some 135 acres of hilly and rocky terrain. At 1,300 feet elevation, the property sits on several large knolls with gentle, hillside slopes and experiences the warm days and cool nights essential for growing top quality wine grapes.

With sixty acres of estate vineyards planted to seventeen Mediterranean varietals, our focus is on growing varietals that time has proven best suited to this site.
