Tasting Notes:

This is a lovely, dry white wine, pale gold in color. Lots of apricot, stone fruit and tropical fruit with nice, bright acidity and mouthfeel with a lingering finish. A Viognier to pair with food, and a great alternative to Chardonnay.

Winemaker Impressions:

Our 2013 Viognier is probably my favorite Viognier to date. This vintage offered up some great fruit and the characteristics of this Viognier are true to the varietal's nature.

Vineyards:

Viognier grapes from our Block 24 were used to produce this wonderful wine.

Winemaking:

Winemaking on this vintage is slightly different than previous productions. It was 90% stainless steel fermented, the remaining 10% done in neutral white barrels with no malolactic fermentation.
