Tasting Notes:

Smooth and distinctive, this lovely vibrant ruby colored Sangiovese is made from grapes lovingly grown at our family estate vineyards. Aromas of black cherries, red plum, thyme, bay and cinnamon are followed by bright acidity with a lingering finish of black pepper and toasty oak.

This wine is an excellent companion for Italian dishes with delicious tomato based sauces and can be enjoyed now or over the next few years.

Located twelve miles south of Grass Valley, California and nestled in the Sierra Foothills, Naggiar Vineyards encompasses some 135 acres of hilly and rocky terrain.
