TASTING NOTES

This seductive, dark garnet colored wine was hand crafted from grapes grown both on our Sierra Foothills estate and sourced from some of the best vineyards in Northern California.

Heady aromas of ripe blackberries, black raspberries, and cassis fill the nose while on the palate, flavors of ripe plums with hints of oak and spices are followed by a long, soft, velvety finish.

This wine will pair well with any number of grilled or barbecued meats, such as grilled steak, barbecued Tri Tip or Spare Ribs.

NAGGIAR VINEYARDS

Located twelve miles south of Grass Valley, California and nestled in the Sierra Foothills, Naggiar Vineyards encompasses some 135 acres of hilly and rocky terrain. At 1,300 feet elevation, the property sits on several large knolls with gentle, hillside slopes and experiences the warm days and cool nights essential for growing top quality wine grapes.

With sixty acres of estate vineyards planted to seventeen Mediterranean varietals, our focus is on growing varietals that time has proven best suited to this site.
