Tasting Notes:

Steep rocky south-facing hillsides, together with warm days and cool nights, have helped create this luscious and lovely dry white wine.

Pale gold in color with aromas of apricots, melon, citrus zest and blossoms, this Viognier has a long finish bringing back memories of warm summer days.

Enjoy on its own or with chicken or seafood dishes. Also pairs well with mild spiced dishes.

Naggiar Vineyards:

Located twelve miles south of Grass Valley, California and Nestled in the Sierra Foothills, Naggiar Vineyards encompasses some 135 acres of hilly and rocky terrain. At 1,300 feet elevation, the property sits on several large knolls with gentle, hillside slopes and experiences the warm days and cool nights essential for growing top quality wine grapes.
