Tasting Notes:

Our 2010 Mourvedre is inky dark in color and full-bodied with good structure and acidity. It exhibits aromas of currants, blackberries and plum along with a touch of fennel/anise to round out the nose. Moderately tannic and reminiscent of a nice, peppery Zinfandel. To be enjoyed with family and friends on a cold winter night with big meat dishes, game and savory stews.

Located twelve miles south of Grass Valley, California and Nestled in the Sierra Foothills, Naggiar Vineyards encompasses some 135 acres of hilly and rocky terrain. At 1,300 feet elevation, the property sits on several large knolls with gentle, hillside slopes and experiences the warm days and cool nights essential for growing top quality wine grapes.
