Tasting Notes:

Warm sunny days, cool nights and steep rocky mountain soils together with the very best hand-picked grapes from two separate Barbera blocks at our family estate vineyards have created this delicious full-bodied deep purple-red Reserve Barbera.

This wine offers wonderful rich aromas and flavors of black cherry, black figs, raspberries with hints of cocoa and fennel rounding off to a long lingering finish.

This wine will pair well with charcuterie, pate, mushroom risotto, hearty casseroles, stews and roasted meats.

Naggiar Vineyards:

Located twelve miles south of Grass Valley, California and Nestled in the Sierra Foothills, Naggiar Vineyards encompasses some 135 acres of hilly and rocky terrain. At 1,300 feet elevation, the property sits on several large knolls with gentle, hillside slopes and experiences the warm days and cool nights essential for growing top quality wine grapes.
