Tasting Notes:

Rocky sloping mountain soils together with sunny days and cool nights have created this lovely concentrated yet elegant blend of Rhone grape varieties from our estate vineyards.

Seductively dark purple in color, this wine boasts intense aromas of plums, earthy truffles, blackberries and black currants. On the palate it is both concentrated and velvety with strong blackberry, hints of cedar and a soft lingering finish.

The complexity and elegance of this wine pairs well with classic French cuisine such as sautéed lamb with garlic and thyme, braised beef, roast leg of lamb and fine French sauces.

Naggiar Vineyards:

Located twelve miles south of Grass Valley, California and nestled in the Sierra Foothills, Naggiar Vineyards encompasses some 135 acres of hilly and rocky terrain. At 1,300 feet elevation, the property sits on several large knolls with gentle, hillside slopes and experiences the warm days and cool nights essential for growing top quality wine grapes.

With sixty acres of estate vineyards planted to seventeen Mediterranean varieties, our focus is on growing varieties that time has proven best suited to this site.
