Tasting Notes:

Shallow rocky mountain soils, long sunny days and gentle afternoon breezes at our family estate vineyards in the Sierra Foothills have helped create this lovely ruby red Syrah. With intriguing aromas of boysenberry, black cherries with hints of violets and coffee, this wine has a full body and a lingering smooth finish.

An excellent companion for barbequed meats such as spare ribs and flavorful meats or chicken dishes.
